



EMPLOYMENT POSTING CROSSING GUARD

The City of Mason will accept applications for the position of Crossing Guard at any time during the year. Crossing Guards are a Seasonal Part-Time position that normally works during the School Year (September – mid June).

Summary:

Under the direction of the Chief of Police or designee, is responsible for providing for the safety of school children crossing at a designated intersection or pedestrian crossing in the City of Mason for public school students.

Education/Requirements

High School Diploma or equivalent, must be able to pass a Criminal History Background check, ability to comprehend and apply crossing guard training required by the department, skill in the techniques of hand signals and traffic control, ability to direct and communicate with children, ability to direct traffic at intersections and the ability to withstand a wide range of outside working conditions.
