Historic District Commission Notice of Vacancies

The City of Mason is currently seeking two individuals with a passion for historic preservation who are interested in volunteering their time as a member of the City's Historic District Commission (HDC). Members are appointed by the mayor with the consent of City Council for three-year terms. Meetings are held every third Monday at 6:00pm as necessary.

The function and duty of the Historic District Commission is to review applications for changes to buildings, and to advise on proper development for sites, properties and historic resources located in the City's established historic district in Downtown Mason. The HDC is also authorized to recommend for the amendments to the City Code, relating to the control and development of lands within historic district and the expansion of historic districts. The duties and powers of the HDC can be found in the City of Mason's Code of Ordinance Part II, Chapter 31, Section 4.

Licensed architects and professional historians, architectural historians, and archaeologists are encouraged to apply, as are individuals with an interest in historic preservation or a background in architecture, history, architectural history, archaeology, planning, construction, real estate, cultural geography, or other related field.
