



# TRASH COLLECTION

## INFORMATION SHEET

**TRASH COLLECTION:** Trash must be placed curbside no later than 7 a.m. on pick-up day, and no earlier than 9 p.m. the evening before. Receptacles must be removed by residents no later than 9 p.m. of trash pick-up day.

**NOTE:** By placing refuse at curbside just prior to 7 a.m. on pick-up day, you reduce incidents of animal involvement. Granger is not responsible for picking up debris caused by torn bags.

**TRASH COLLECTION DAYS:** EAST SIDE – Monday

WEST SIDE – Friday (Friday pick-up includes both sides of Jefferson Street.)

Trash should be placed in bags before being placed in the Cart provided by Granger. Any bags that do not fit in the cart may be placed next to the cart for collection. Please do not use any non-commercial containers for trash.

Building materials (regardless of size or amount) such as cement, lumber, drywall, insulation, etc. will not be picked up, nor will sod. Tires will not be picked up.

**COST OF SERVICE (July 2020):** \$174.31 per year, per dwelling unit. The cost is billed separately on the summer tax statement.

**HOLIDAYS:** The following holidays are observed by the refuse collection company: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, 4<sup>th</sup> of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. If one of these holidays falls on a Monday, then both pick-up days are changed to Tuesday and Saturday, respectively. If one of these holidays fall on a Tuesday through Friday, then only the Friday pick-up day is changed to Saturday.

**LARGE HOUSEHOLD ITEMS:** Large items such as furniture, appliances and mattresses, can be picked up by Granger using a special truck. There is no additional charge for pick-up, but these items may not be picked up on your regular trash day. Call the Granger office at 517.372.2800 to schedule a different pick-up day using a special truck.

**SENIORS, Free Refuse Service (July 2020):** If you are 65 years of age, a homeowner, have resided at current residence for at least the entire previous calendar year, and have a total household income that does not exceed \$31,627.00 annually, you can contact City Hall to arrange for free refuse services. \*\*Deadline for adjustments is September 15<sup>th</sup>.

Senior Citizens or physically challenged persons, unable to place their refuse at the curb, please contact our Customer Service Desk.
